STATE OF MICHIGAN 53RD CIRCUIT COURT CHEBOYGAN and PRESQUE ISLE COUNTY STANDARD PARENTING TIME SCHEDULE

The Standard Parenting Time Guideline is for parents who live within two (2) hours driving time from each other. The parenting schedule is as follows:

Weekend Parenting Time

The non-custodial parent is entitled to parenting time on alternating weekends from Friday 7:00 p.m. – Sunday 7:00 p.m.

Summer Parenting Time

The non-custodial parent is entitled to summer parenting time relative to the child's age as outlined below:

<u>O-Age 2</u>: In addition to every other weekend Friday 7:00 p.m. – Sunday 7:00 p.m., the non-custodial parent is entitled to one (1) week of parenting time in July beginning the third Sunday of July to the following Sunday. NCP to receive credit for 64.5 overnights.

Age 3-6: In addition to every other weekend Friday 7:00 p.m. – Sunday 7:00 p.m., the non-custodial parent is entitled to one (1) week in June, one (1) week in July and one (1) week in August, each beginning the first Friday of the month of the non-custodial parents regular parenting time weekend. NCP to receive credit for 77 overnights.

Ages 7 and up: The non-custodial parent is entitled to ½ of the summer school break. The parties will alternate week on/week off beginning with the non-custodial parent having the first Sunday after school release at 7:00 p.m. until the following Sunday at 7:00 p.m. continuing until the evening prior to school commencing. NCP to receive credit for 95.5 overnights.

For summer parenting time, when there is more than one (1) minor child named on the Order, the parenting time will follow the schedule for the oldest child. The age of the child at the beginning of the summer governs the summer parenting time schedule for the entire summer.

The payer of support shall notify the Friend of the Court in writing upon change of overnights sufficient to warrant a child support review.

Transportation & Exchange Time

The exchange time for regularly scheduled parenting time and holiday parenting time shall be 7:00 p.m. with receiving parent to provide transportation.

If a parent is not available to transport the minor child(ren) for their parenting time, a parent may appoint another responsible adult who is familiar with the child(ren) to provide transportation on that parent's behalf. If a transportation emergency arises and the designated driver will be late, the delay must be communicated to the other parent and the standard wait time is thirty minutes unless otherwise agreed.

Holiday Parenting Time

Holiday Parenting Time supersedes all regularly scheduled parenting time. Your regularly scheduled parenting time schedule shall continue in the same scheduled rotation as if the holiday did not occur.
